Albert Lohe, who was born in GF was a sign painter by trade and was well liked. His quiet home loving nature bade him think more of others than hiself. Member of Painters Local Union 260. 20 years old. Early December he enlisted in the medical department of the army and was sent to Camp Kelly 1, near San Antonio. Later assigned to 66th Aerial squadron and was on his way to France when taken ill with pneumonia at Garden City, NY, where he passed away after only a few days illness at age 20 and one day. Sergeant McDole registered at Osterman precinct, about 30 miles southeast of Big Sandy, and stated that his parents lived at Cottage Grove, Oregon. Lane County News. Former Cottage Grove Boy Dies at Camp Lewis. Cottage Grove, Or., April 1.—Sergeant Jesse E. McDole, of Cottage Grove died at Camp Lewis March 29 of measles, followed by pneumonia. He is the first one of our boys who have gone to the front to die. Jesse was born at Drain April 19, 1894, had lived in Cottage Grove until a year ago when he went to Montana entering the service there last September in the Montana artillery, 348th Regiment.
