MONTANANS IN RELIEF

At 1 am on October 6, a patrol of ten men from Company D, 308th Infantry was sent forward to attempt to break through German lines to reach Major Whittlesey and the Lost Battalion. The attempt failed and half of the patrol including Montanan Mike Preputin were killed.

Private Ausenhus was Killed in Action four days late, while Private Brown died of Spinal Meningitis on January 22, 1919.

James E. Mooney, fingerprint expert at Butte police headquarters, enjoyed a visit yesterday with Herbert Beuskens of Ekalaka. The two were members of the 'Lost Battalion' in the World War. There are several survivors now living in Montana.

Both were in Company K, 307th Infantry, 77th Division, which with elements of the 306th and 308th [sic: battalions] regiments, were bottle up for seven days while the enemy's guns thinned their ranks. Major C. W. Whittlesey and his men were isolated, cut off from the Allies, supplies, and rations.

Finally, when few of the men remained alive and uninjured, the 154th Brigade effected their rescue after finding it necessary to lay down a barrage through and over the "Lost Battalion." [Montana Standard 21 July 1939, p. 5]

Missoula, Sept 15.—Years ago, in the cow country, Jack Gould rode the range and like other men of his class, drank freely, for liquor was not frowned upon as in these days. He likewise toted a gun, and knew how to use it, for that was part of the equipment on the range, with the old “F.U.F.” outfit.

Jack came to Missoula a few days ago and got in bad. The old longing for a spree lured him away from the path of sobriety and he got “liquored-up” and unfortunately had a loaded gun in his possession when picked up by the police, and is now facing a charge of carrying concealed weapons.

A Splendid Record. And that is not all. Jack has a past, a past record of which he may well be proud. He is a survivor of the famous Lost Battalion, which in the Argonne forest, from October 2 to 8, was cut off from all assistance and alone withstood the bitter assaults of the Germans until help arrived, only to find a greater portion of the battalion dead and the few survivors wounded.

“Yes, I was wounded late on the afternoon of the third,” said Gould. “Here’s where the Huns got me,” and rolling up his sleeve he displayed a nasty scar where he forearm had been penetrated by a machine gun bullet.

Could Do Nothing But Fight. "What did you do? Where you knocked out?"

"Just kept on fighting. That's all a fellow could do. Gave his first aid and let 'er go at that. I got along pretty well until a piece of shrapnel caught me two or three days later in the left shoulder. She tore wide and deep and that was what put me in the hospital after we were found. But I went in to see a little fun and I guess I found it," said Jack.

Both were in Company K, 307th Infantry, 77th Division, which with elements of the 306th and 308th [sic: battalions] regiments, were bottle up for seven days while the enemy's guns thinned their ranks. Major C. W. Whittlesey and his men were isolated, cut off from the Allies, supplies, and rations.

Finally, when few of the men remained alive and uninjured, the 154th Brigade effected their rescue after finding it necessary to lay down a barrage through and over the "Lost Battalion."
